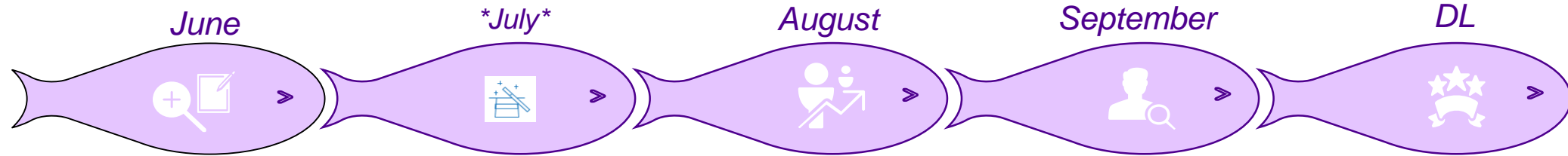

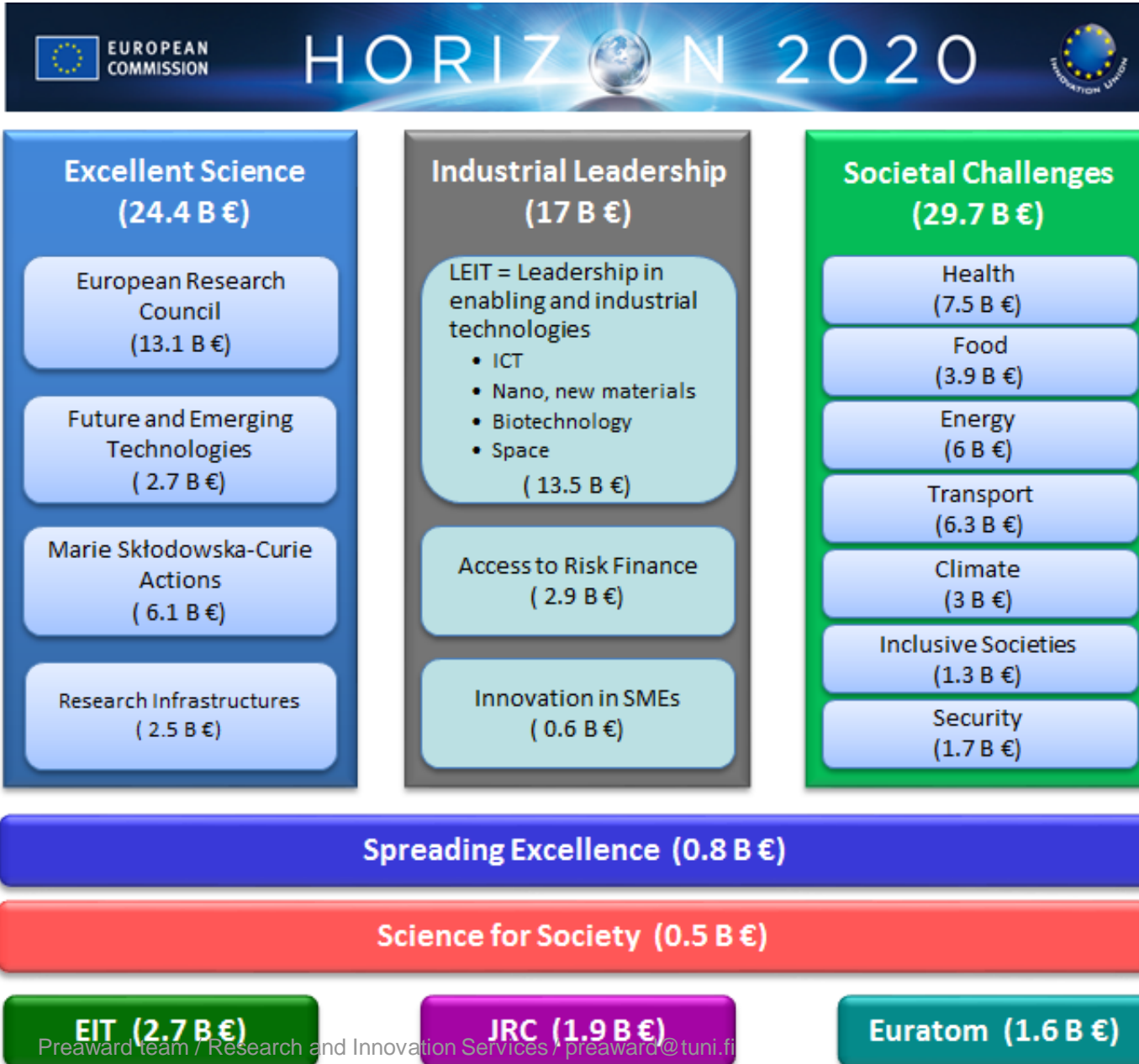

What is Horizon 2020

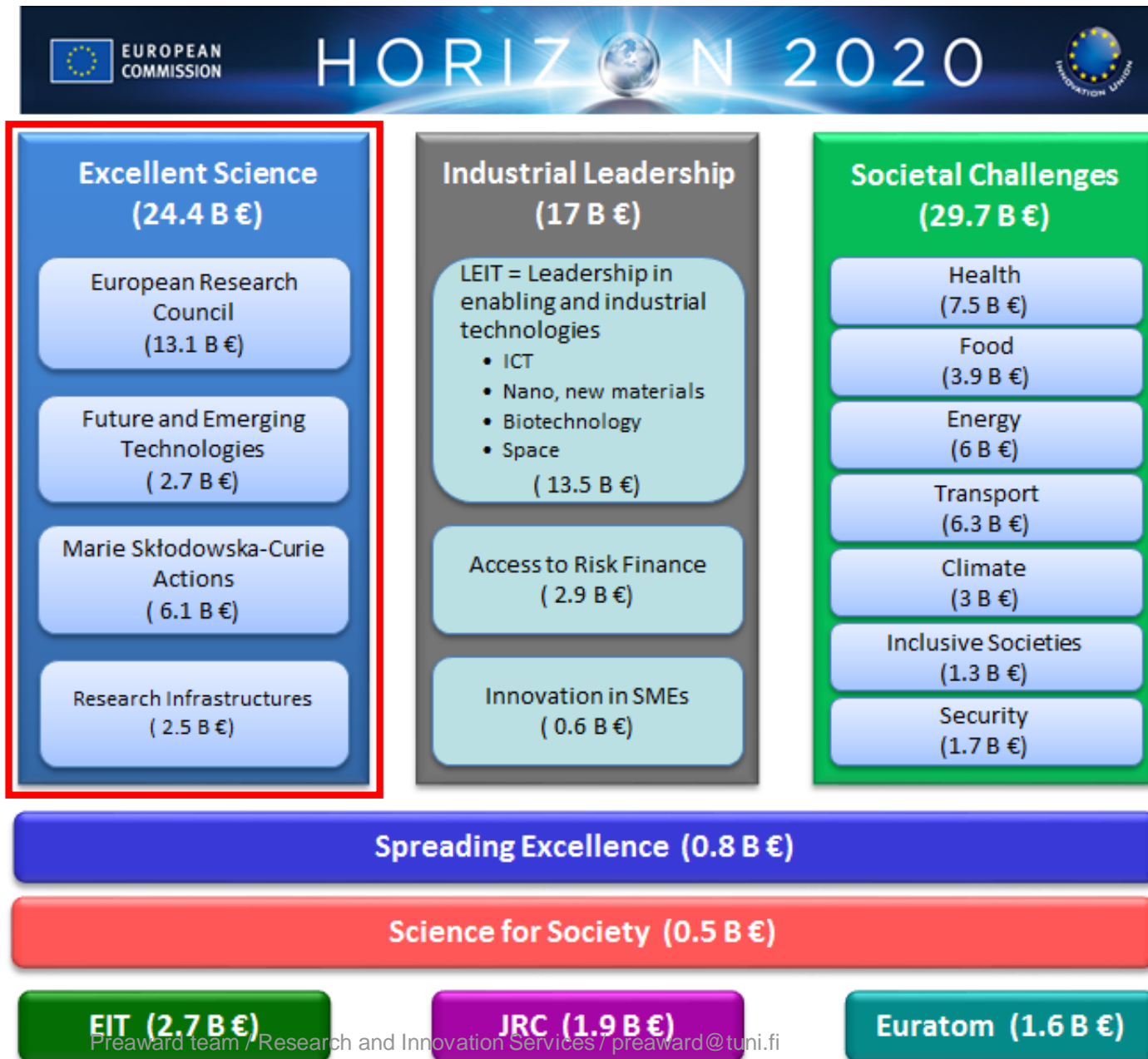
- European framework program 2014-2020
- Funds research and innovation (grants for basic and applied research)
- Budget nearly 80 billion euros

→ There are still plenty of opportunities for research funding during the last 1,5 years of the program – so let's apply!



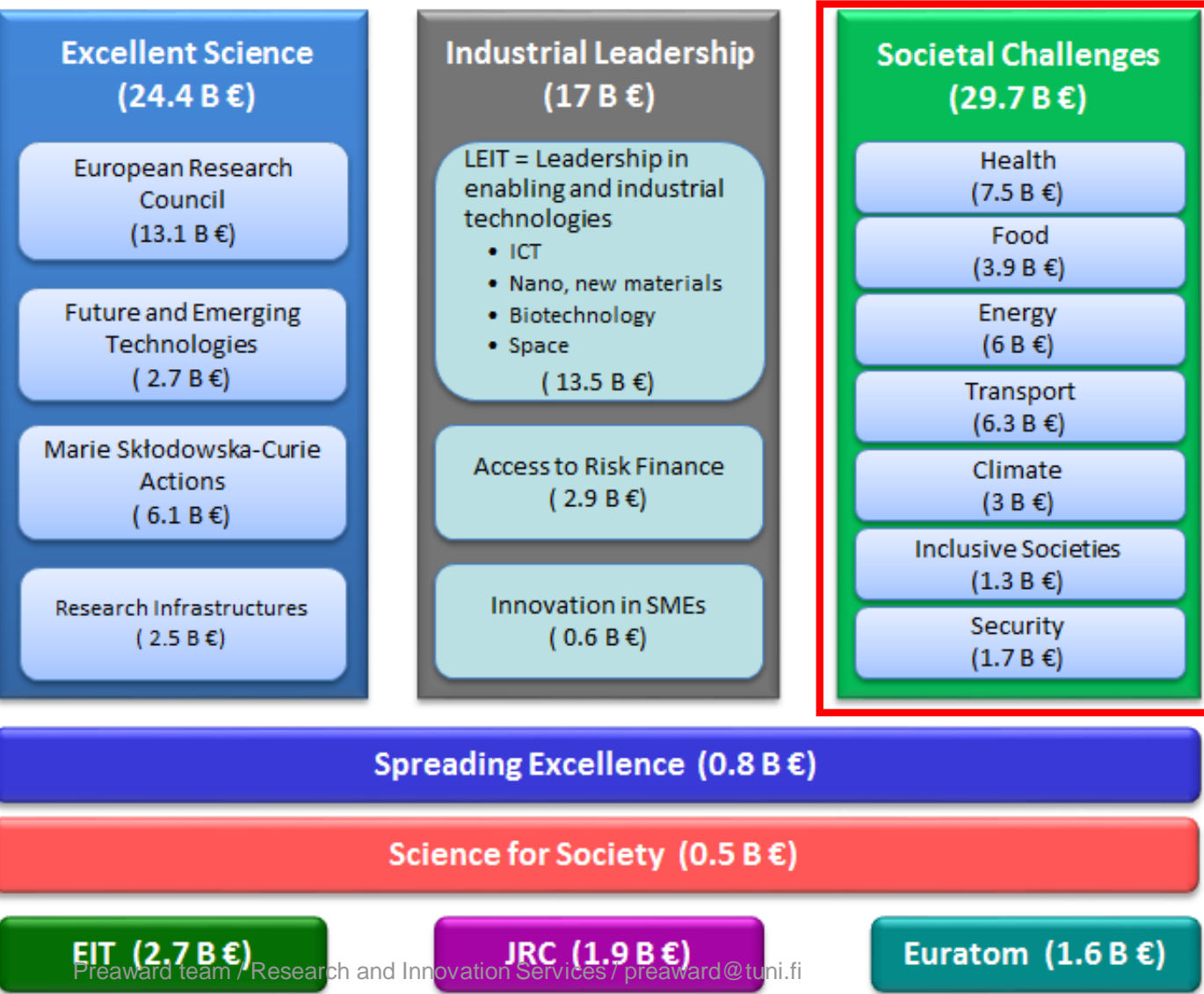
How is Horizon 2020 organized?

- Horizon 2020 is organized in different priority areas: the three pillars
- Different types of funding opportunities in each pillar



PILLAR 1: EXCELLENT SCIENCE (Huipputason tiede)

- World class science is the foundation of tomorrow's technologies, jobs and wellbeing
- Europe needs to develop, attract and retain research talent
- Researchers need access to the best infrastructures



PILLAR 3: SOCIETAL CHALLENGES (Yhteiskunnalliset haasteet)

- Concerns of citizens and society/**EU policy objectives** (climate, health, environment, energy, transport, etc.) cannot be achieved without innovation
- Breakthrough solutions come from **multi-disciplinary collaborations**, including social sciences & humanities
- Promising solutions need to be tested, demonstrated and scaled up

Funding and Tender opportunities portal

- Previously known as “Participant Portal”

- Includes for instance

- Calls for proposals
- Guidelines for applying
- Submission system
- Also other programs in addition to H2020
- Project management tools

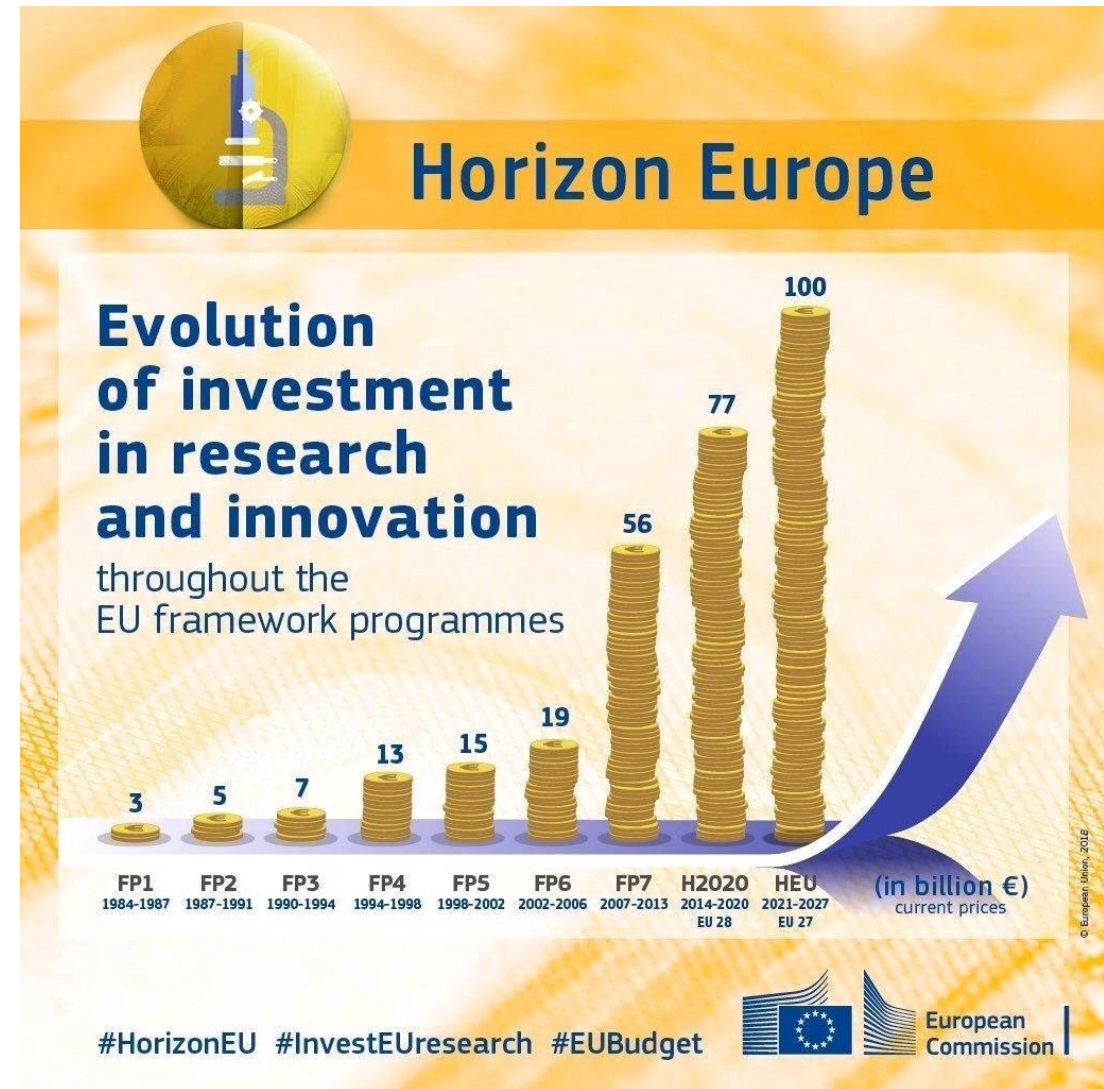
Postaward support for H2020 projects

- Service provided to support coordinated H2020 projects' administration and finance
- Includes the whole project life cycle
 - GAP: GA, CA
 - During project: recruitment support, payments, meetings, reporting support, supporting partners (participant portal, MSCA rules, admin & finance), communication with PO & partners etc.
 - After project: Final reporting and payments
- In practise: Administrative Project Manager is part of Research Services staff but works as part of project team 30-40% of his/her working time (hour allocation by SoleTM)

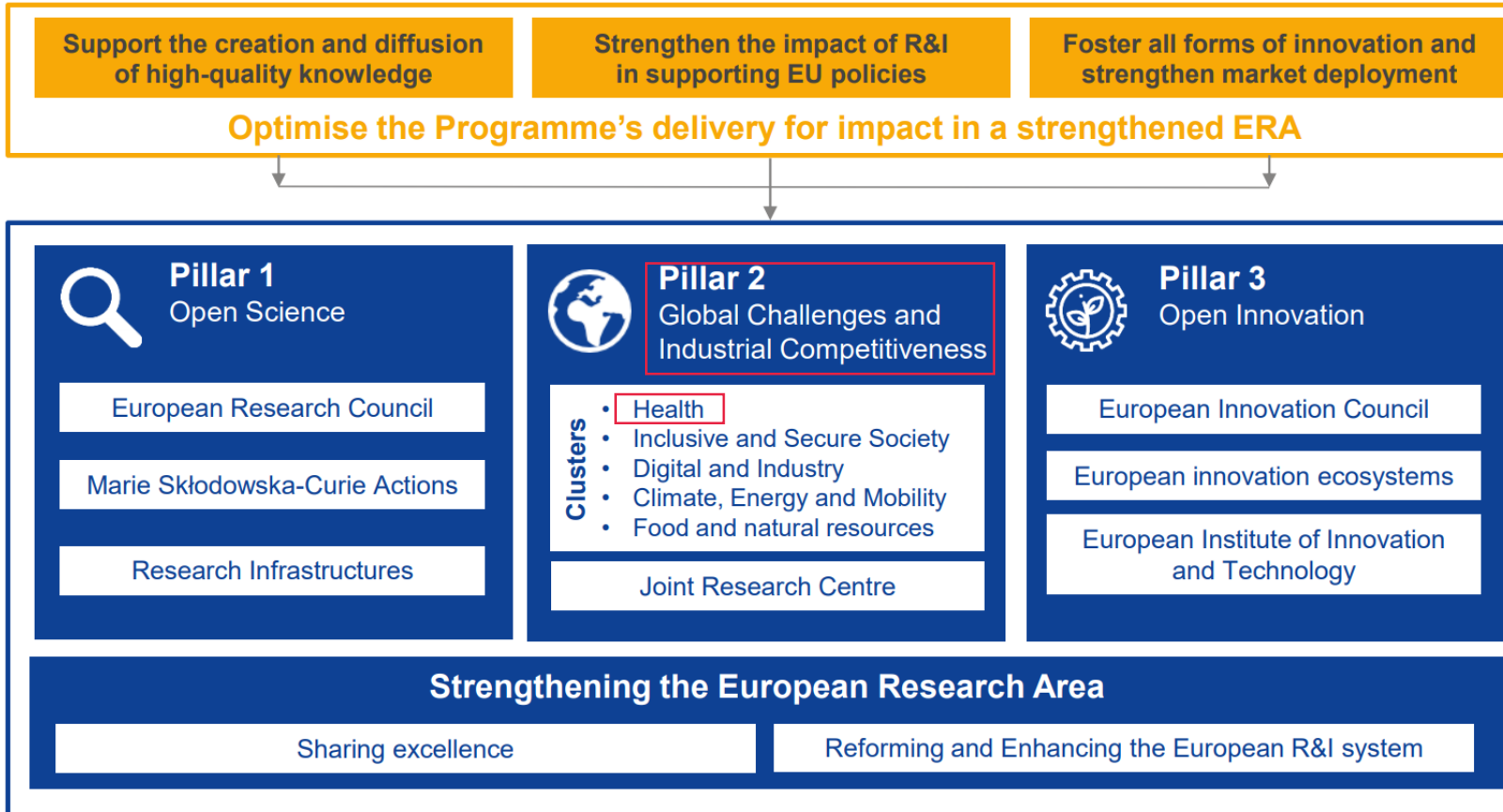

- Health education and digital health literacy



#6 Health Care Systems

Health systems are a key asset of the EU social system. We shall keep them accessible, resilient and sustainable and harness the potential of data-driven and digital innovation.

- Reforms in public health systems and policies
- New models for health and care and future workforce
- Improving health technology assessment
- Use of health data respecting security, privacy and interoperability
