# Globelics network

- Initiated around 2000 by innovation scholars coming from the North (Christopher Freeman, Richard Nelson, Luc Soete and Bengt-Åke Lundvall) and from the South (José Cassiolato, K.J. Joseph, Shulin Gu and Mammo Muchie).
- Over time the network has integrated expertise from a wider social science background and experts on broader aspects of development.
- >2000 scholars and 350 Globelics Academy alumnies

- To contribute to scientific capacity building through networking.
- To contribute to the knowledge base for strategies and policies linking innovation to economic development.
- To develop a platform both for North-South and for South-South collaboration.
- To help Ph.D.-students to pursue high quality research in the field innovation and development.

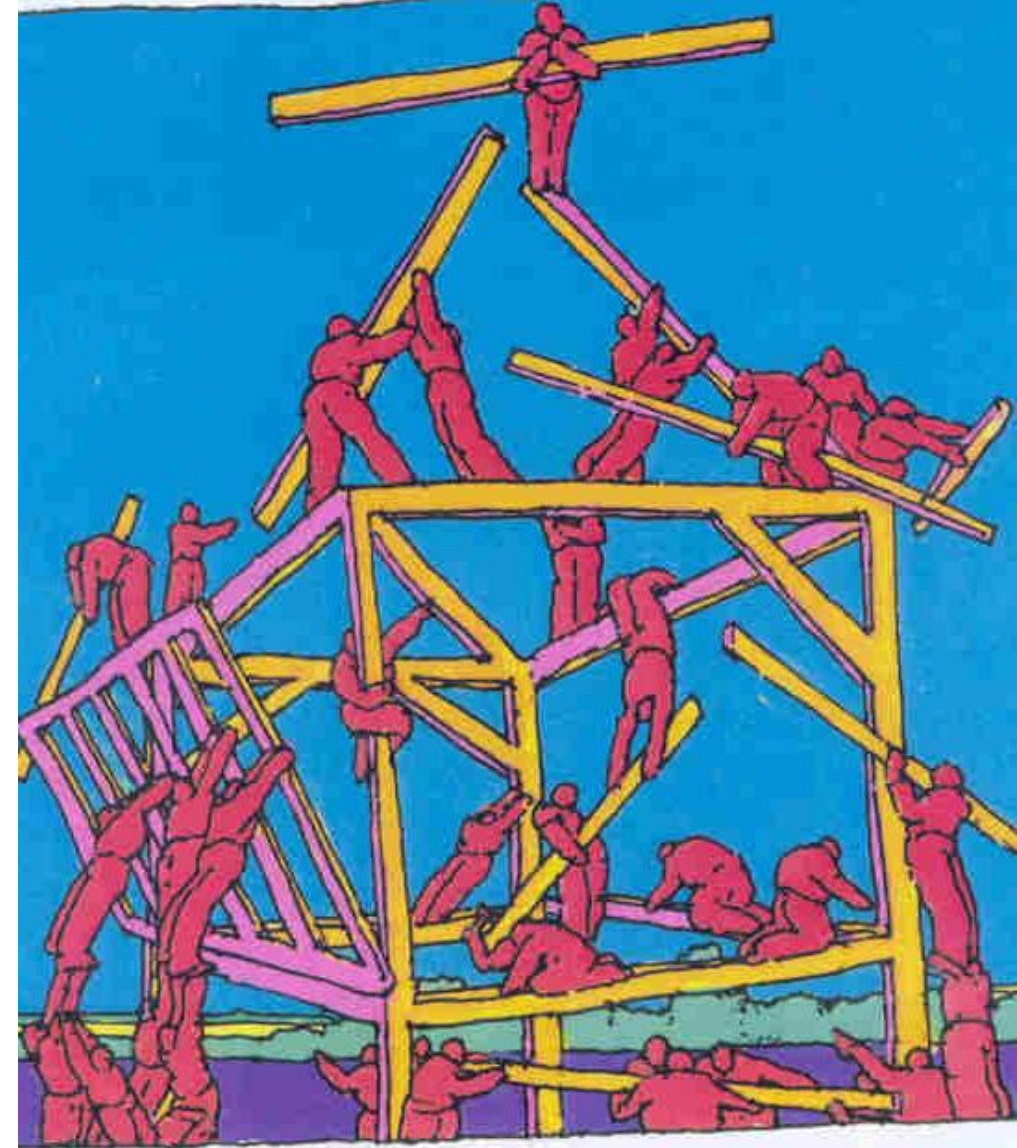
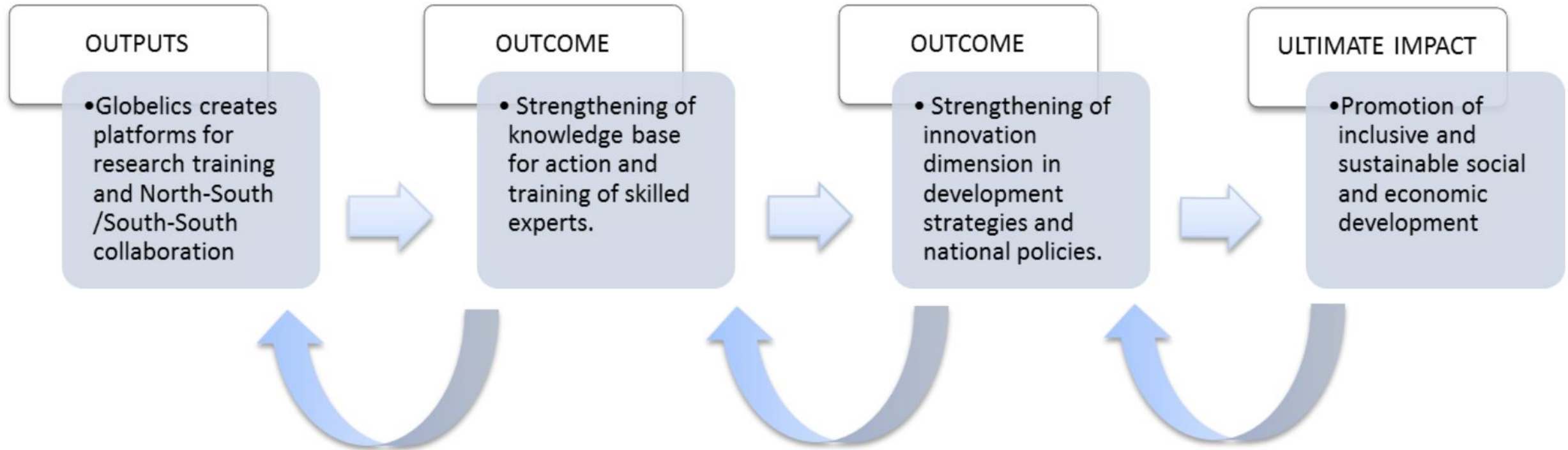
