Special Call for Abstracts Related to Development or Scientific Projects

The paper poster format is A0 (vertical). Abstracts chosen as posters should be prepared by the presenter. At least one of the authors must register as a conference participant and present the abstract either in an oral session or as a poster in the poster session (NOTE! Early bird fees are applicable for all accepted abstract authors). Accepted abstracts will be published in the Conference Book. The best project introduction will be rewarded. The best abstracts are invited to be published as full papers in a special #eHealth2024 issue of Finnish Journal of eHealth and eWelfare.

Use the **Word template** provided on the conference website to write your abstract. It will ensure that your text is not exceeding one page. Too long abstracts will be rejected. For your reference, the main page layout details are here, but it is better to use the template!
